

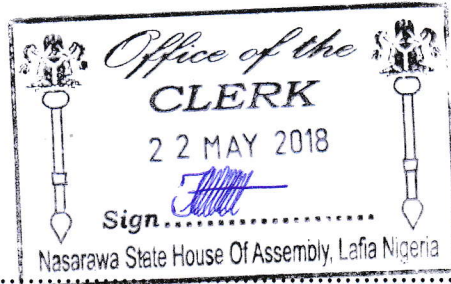
**LAW TO AMEND THE NASARAWA STATE INTERNAL REVENUE  
SERVICE LAW NO. 85 OF 2010**

BE IT ENACTED by the Nasarawa State House of Assembly and by the authority of same as follows: Enactment

- S.1. This law may be cited as the Nasarawa State Internal Revenue Service (Amendment) law (hereafter referred to as the "Principal Law") 2018 and shall come into operation on 1<sup>st</sup> January, 2018. Citation and commencement.
- S.2. Paragraph g of the subsection 2 of section 33 of the Principal law is amended by deleting the word "part time" and substituting thereof the word "permanent".
- S.3. Paragraph (a) of Section 14 of the principal law is amended by deleting the number 5% and substituting it thereof with the number 10%.


